

Responsive Fellowships

Competitive Kress Fellowships administered by the Kress Foundation are awarded to art historians and art conservators in the final stages of their preparation for professional careers, as well as to art museum curators and educators.

Fellowship Guidelines

A limited number of “Responsive Fellowships” are awarded to individuals whose projects are central to the mission of the Foundation, but fall outside the main Fellowship areas.

Application procedures: Candidate must submit letter of intent, 2-3 page description of project/program and budget detail.

Application Deadline:

Application Materials

- ▶ A brief description of the Fellowship including the scope of work to be completed and an indication of the department structure in which the candidate will work
- ▶ To whom the Fellow will report
- ▶ The dates for the Fellowship
- ▶ Curriculum vitae of the individual nominated
- ▶ Three (3) letters of recommendation
- ▶ Self-addressed, stamped postcard
